## New Projects under discussion for 2026-27

### Project Details

**Vivekananda Kendra Vidyalaya, Badarpur, Assam:** SF is discussing with Vivekananda Kendra Vidyalaya (VKV), Assam, the construction of four classrooms, proposed during the year. VKV institutions provide quality, value-based education to students from rural and underserved communities across North-East India. The proposed support will strengthen educational infrastructure and improve learning access for deserving students from remote villages.

**Jain Mission Hospital, Chikkaballapur:** SF is evaluating support for establishing a Surgical Intensive Care Unit (SICU) at Jain Mission Hospital to strengthen critical care services for rural and semi-urban communities. The project includes advanced post-surgical care facilities and modern life-saving equipment to improve patient recovery and surgical outcomes. SF had earlier established a dialysis centre at the hospital.

**Koira Lake Rejuvenation Project:** SF is planning to support the Koira Lake Rejuvenation Project in Devanahalli Taluk, Bengaluru Rural District, aimed at restoring and rejuvenating the lake. The initiative is expected to improve water storage, groundwater recharge, biodiversity, and provide long-term environmental and livelihood benefits to nearby rural communities and farmers.

**E-Shala Digital Teacher Initiative:** SF is planning to support the E-Shala Digital Teacher Initiative to strengthen digital learning in government schools, especially single-teacher and under-resourced schools. The initiative proposes E-Shala Digital Classrooms with smart TVs, bilingual digital content, interactive modules, and classroom support infrastructure to improve learning outcomes and support multi-grade teaching in rural schools.

**Establishment of Dialysis centre:** Support for establishment of a dialysis centre at Indiranagar in association with Rotary Indiranagar Trust, aimed at providing accessible and affordable dialysis care to economically disadvantaged patients.
